



STAGE PLOT TOOLS

Installation and Operation Manual

Paez440PRO Stage Plot Tools creates a technical stage drawing, input and output lists, and production notes. Data is stored locally in the browser and can be organized by project.

Installation

1. Open the public link in Safari, Chrome or Edge.
2. To install: iPhone/iPad, Share → Add to Home Screen; Android/Chrome, menu → Install app; computer, select Install when offered.
3. Open once while online so offline files can be stored.
4. Grant camera or microphone permission only when the selected tool requests it.
5. When Update appears, close other product tabs, select Update and reopen.

Safety and scope. These tools assist calculation, documentation and comparison. They do not replace manufacturer documentation, a calibrated instrument or the responsible technician's judgment. Use safe levels and verify everything before the show.

Operation

Event information

1. Enter artist, venue, date, engineer and available details.
2. Add the event logo when needed.
3. Save the project with a clear name before major edits.

Visual Stage Plot

1. Enter stage width, depth and unit.
2. Drag instruments and equipment from the bank onto the stage.
3. Move, rotate and organize each item; add risers and dimensions as needed.

Input and Output Lists

1. Complete channel, source, microphone/DI, stand, phantom and notes.
2. Complete outputs, mixes, destinations and comments.
3. Keep the order consistent with console and stagebox patching.

Projects and safety

1. The app auto-saves in this browser.
2. Use Save project and Open to manage versions.
3. Do not clear browser data or rely on private browsing as the only storage. Export a final copy.

PDF

1. Check that no items sit outside the stage.

2. Confirm lists and power notes.
3. Select Export to PDF and use the print dialog to save or print.

Test checklist

- ☐ Open the link on another phone or computer.
- ☐ Switch ES/EN.
- ☐ Test installation and offline opening.
- ☐ Run every function with known data.
- ☐ If anything fails, capture the full screen and record device, browser and exact steps.

Technical report

Include product, device, operating-system version, browser, permissions, exact steps, expected result, actual result and a complete screenshot. Do not include confidential client information in a test report.
